

#24 PAINT IT BLACK Don't be afraid of the dark! Here, we explain how to create a black feature wall and accessorise with the best monochrome fabrics and furnishings Used to coat an entire wall black, the 'queen of all colours' as artist Pierre-Auguste Renoir described it, can have quite an impact. The trick to applying this light-absorbing shade in a way that doesn't overpower a room is to use a limewash that is loaded with pigment. producing a soft, velvety texture. Francesca Wezel, founder of Francesca's Paints, explains that paint dries 70 per cent lighter than it looks when wet and, if applied using criss-cross brush strokes, the finish will have natural light and shade. Try 'Coopers Creek', £87.88 for

five litres, Francesca's Paints (francescaspaint.com).
