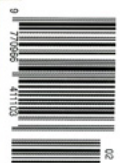

## SUSTAINABLE PAINTS: WHAT TO LOOK FOR WHEN IT COMES TO COLOUR

Painted kitchens are one of the most popular recycled styles right now. I'm often asked these questions about eco-friendly paint...



### What is eco-friendly paint?

Sustainable paint contains little or no VOCs (volatile organic compounds).

These are often human-made chemicals that contain nasty toxins and could irritate your throat or even make you feel dizzy and nauseous.

### What should I look for when buying?

Check the label to see if the paint is free from oils, acrylics, and vinyl – some are made from materials, such as clay, lime. Francisco's Paints' water-based Eco Emulsion – you can use it on interior walls or ceilings for a beautiful, chalky, velvety finish.



### Can I have a sustainable painted kitchen?

I'm seeing a rise in painted recycled kitchens as renovators see that a simple repaint and new handles can create a stunning scheme that looks new – your project could be more sustainable and economical this way.
